# ENGINEER'S REPORT:

#### New Bathrooms & Bleachers at Bruno Mellini Park

The project is complete and close out is in process.

#### Mazzoni Property

The State's September 22, 2004 response indicated that they would require further off-site groundwater investigation. We have received \$85,622 in additional NJDEP grant funds to complete the site investigation. We are also working with SJEDA to evaluate the use of this site for solar power generation and other funding options.

# **Central Avenue Sidewalk and Lighting Improvements**

We received NJDOT final reimbursement and the project is in the maintenance period.

#### Bathroom Improvements at Bruno Mellini Park

Complete project funding was received from ACIA and the project is in the maintenance period.

# 2003 CDBG- Sumner Street Playground

Complete project funding was received from ACIA and the project is in the maintenance period.

# Reconstruction of Muccio, Ott & Martinelli Drives

Arawak Paving Co. has substantially completed the project. The work is in good condition with the exception of one area of settlement near the southern intersection of Muccio Dr. and Martinelli Ave.

#### Reconstruction of Laurel Street – 2007 State Aid

We have awarded a contract to Asphalt Paving Co. of Malaga for the reconstruction of Laurel Street from the Blvd. to Summer Ave. The work is currently on hold and will resume in the spring due to weather conditions.

#### **Additional Items**

Lauren Court subdivision site work is ongoing. The developer has received a soil conservation approval.

Final approval of the Minotola Estates project is being delayed due to NJDEP permit requirements. The developer is proceeding at risk anticipating the NJDEP approvals.

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Sherwood Forest Homes has substantially completed site improvements. The developer proposed an amendment to his subdivision approval and it was denied. The construction schedule of this project is unknown at this time.

The DCA has approved a portion of the Commerce Center redevelopment area. We are working with NJDCA to add the Mazzoni property to the Commerce Center area.

The Route 54 Redevelopment Plan will have to be amended as a condition of Pinelands certification.

We have completed work on the class B recycling permit for the landfill. We will submit the permit pending Councils approval of the permit fee.

Council is in the process of revising the PR-3 minimum lot size per the planning board recommendation. The Midway redevelopment area should see some significant improvement over this year. The motel site will be improved and a new development is proposed at the Midway Inn site.

We have prepared an application to the County to extend the bike path through our new Blackwater Pond property and along North Blvd. Resolutions will be needed authorizing the application(s).

The State Bureau of Recycling is offering a poetry contest for children. The Notre Dame Regional School and Cleary Middle School fifth and sixth grades will be entering the contest.

The next meeting for the Recreation Commission will be Wednesday, February 6<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 p.m. in Borough Hall.
