The regular meeting of Mayor and Council of the Borough of Buena was held Monday, February 8, 2010, commencing at 7:00 p.m. at the Borough Hall with Mayor Baruffi presiding. Mayor Baruffi gave a brief update on Borough owned buildings. After the discussion Mayor Baruffi asked Council Members to consider breaking the lease on the old municipal building with the Buena Historical Society so the building can be demolished.

Councilwoman Andaloro and Councilman Baker attended the CDBG Meeting on February 2<sup>nd</sup>. Applications for 2010 funds must be in by March 5<sup>th</sup>. Anticipated allocation is \$30,500.00. The Borough is in the low to moderate income area.
