WHEREAS, the New Jersey Administrative Code, Title 17, Chapter 30 was adopted to set forth the rules regarding the licensing of personal use cannabis businesses within the State of New Jersey, among other regulations; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory Commission (CRC) submitted a Memorandum dated December 10, 2021, a copy which is attached hereto that provides "Guidance for Local Support" which sets forth a requirement that the governing body of a municipality must adopt a resolution "as evidence of local support" containing a statement that includes:

- a. the license applicant's legal name under which they are registered to do business in the State of New Jersey
- b. A determination that the municipality has authorized the type of cannabis business license being sought by the license-applicant to operate within its jurisdiction; and
- c. A confirmation that if the municipality has imposed a limit on the number of licensed cannabis businesses, the issuance of a license to the license applicant by the Commission would not exceed that limit; and

WHEREAS, Borough Council finds that the requirements that the Governing Body provide "local support" at the application stage as outlined herein above and in the Memorandum of the CRC is not a function of the legislative branch of the municipal government and to provide "local support" before obtaining site control and site plan approval from the appropriate Land Use Board is inappropriate; and

WHEREAS, Borough Council recognizes the benefits of licensing cannabis businesses within the

Borough of Buena including creation of economic development, tax ratables and job creation and therefore finds it to be in the best interest of the City to comply with the CRC Memorandum dated December 10 2021 to the extent it has the authority to do so; and

WHEREAS, Organic Green Buds LLC, Wayne, New Jersey, has applied to the CRC for approval of a conditional license for a cultivator to operate an adult personal-use cannabis business in the State of New Jersey and the CRC has found their application complete, has scored sufficiently high to be issued a conditional license, is qualified to hold a conditional license pursuant to N.J.A.C. 17:30-7.4 and has paid the appropriate fee to the CRC as outlined in the letter dated March 28, 2022 attached hereto and made a part hereof upon which Council shall rely; and

WHEREAS, Organic Green Buds LLC now seeks "local support" in the form specified in the aforementioned Memorandum and Borough Council finds it to be in the best interest of the Borough to provide a resolution as specified herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Borough of Buena as follows:

- a. in reliance upon the CRC investigation of Organic Green Buds LLC and the Notice of Application Acceptance, the license applicants legal name is as set forth in the application and approval of the CRC dated October 28, 2022.
- b. Borough of Buena did not adopt an Ordinance on or before August 21, 2021 to either prohibit or limit the number of cannabis establishments within the Borough and therefore all classes of cannabis businesses are permitted within the Borough but restricted to certain zones in accordance with Section 31b of P.L. 2021.c.16.
- c. At the time of the adoption of this Resolution the issuance of a license to Organic Green Buds LLC for a cultivator's license would not exceed a limit imposed by Borough Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that nothing contained herein shall be relied upon as granting any form of license or land use approvals by the Governing Body or the Administration for the operation of any cannabis business within the Borough of Buena and that the intent of this Resolution is solely to comply with the Memorandum of the New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory Commission dated December 10, 2021 so as to allow continued consideration for an annual license by the CRC.

Grant Applications

- 1. FY2023 NJDCA Local Recreation Improvement Grant (LRIG)
 - ➤ Our office completed and submitted the concept site plan and engineer's estimate to the Aubrey Group on January 10th.
 - ➤ It is our understanding that the Aubrey Group has submitted the grant application to the NJDCA which is currently under review.

Capital Projects

FY2022 and FY2023 NJDOT Municipal Aid - Reconstruction of E. Flower Street and South Boulevard

- ➤ The Borough has been notified by the NJDOT that \$285,000.00 in FY2022 Grant funds have been awarded for the reconstruction of E. Flower Street, E. Summer Road and South Boulevard.
- ➤ The Borough has been notified by the NJDOT that \$261,640.00 in FY2023 Grant funds have been awarded for the reconstruction of E. Flower Street, E. Summer Road and South Boulevard.
- ➤ Due to the fact that the project costs exceed the combined grant amounts and there appears to be a potential sanitary sewer pipe collapse on E. Summer Road, the Borough has decided to proceed with just South Boulevard and E. Flower Street.
- ➤ The design phase is complete and we have uploaded the contract documents to NJDOT online for project concurrence. We expect an answer in 1-2 weeks and will be ready to advertise for bidding in July.

1. Cannabis Zoning Map

> Our office has been authorized to proceed with the preparation of a Cannabis Zoning Map. The map has been finalized and has been adopted by Council.

2. ADA Accessibility of Borough Buildings

Our office solicited the services of McLees Architecture to provide a proposal for services relating to the replacement of ADA doors at three (3) Municipal Buildings; the Borough Hall, the Louise Basile Center and the Historical Society. ADA bathrooms and emergency hall lights were also explored at the Historical Society. Our office has provided the Borough with a proposal and we are awaiting direction.

3. Zoning Map

Our office completed a new Zoning Map which has been adopted by Borough Council.
