**MAYOR'S REPORT:**

**NEED MOTION TO OPEN PUBLIC HEARING ON:**

**ORDINANCE NO. 618      CALENDAR YEAR 2014 ORDINANCE TO EXCEED THE MUNICIPAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION LIMITS AND TO ESTABLISH A CAP BANK (N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14) m/Cugini s/Zappariello**

**WHEREAS**, the Local Government Cap Law, N.J.S. 40A: 4-45.1 et seq., provides that in the preparation of its annual budget, a municipality shall limit any increase in said budget up to .5% unless authorized by ordinance to increase it to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, subject to certain exceptions; and,

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.15a provides that a municipality may, when authorized by ordinance, appropriate the difference between the amount of its actual final appropriation and the 3.5% percentage rate as an exception to its final appropriations in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Council of the Borough of Buena in the County of Atlantic finds it advisable and necessary to increase its CY 2014 budget by up to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, in the interest of promoting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Council hereby determines that a 3.0% increase in the budget for said year, amounting to \$94,026.99 in excess of the increase in final appropriations otherwise permitted by the Local Government Cap Law, is advisable and necessary; and,

**WHEREAS** the Borough Council hereby determines that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Buena, in the County of Atlantic, a majority of the full authorized membership of this governing body affirmatively concurring, that, in the CY 2014 budget year, the final appropriations of the Borough of Buena shall, in accordance with this ordinance and N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.14, be increased by 3.5 %, amounting to \$109,698.16, and that the CY 2014 municipal budget for the Borough of Buena be approved and adopted in accordance with this ordinance; and,

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, that any that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, that a certified copy of this ordinance as introduced be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services within 5 days of introduction; and,

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, that a certified copy of this ordinance upon adoption, with the recorded vote included thereon, be filed with said Director within 5 days after such adoption.

**A RESOLUTION TO ENDORSE THE SUBMISSION BY THE BOROUGH OF BUENA OF THE 2013 MUNICIPAL RECYCLING TONNAGE GRANT APPLICATION TO THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION, OFFICE OF RECYCLING AND TO DESIGNATE WILLIAM NIMOHAY TO ENSURE THAT THE SAID APPLICATION IS PROPERLY FILED.**

**WHEREAS**, the Mandatory Source Separation and Recycling Act, P.L. 1987, c.102, has established a recycling fund from which tonnage grants may be made to municipalities in order to encourage local source separation and recycling programs; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the intent and spirit of Mandatory Source Separation and

Recycling Act to use the tonnage grants to develop new municipal recycling programs and to continue and expand existing programs; and

**WHEREAS**, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection has promulgating recycling regulations to implement the Mandatory Recycling Act; and

**WHEREAS**, the recycling regulations impose on municipalities certain requirements as a condition for applying for tonnage grants including, but not limited to, making and keeping accurate verifiable records of materials collected and claimed by the municipality; and

**WHEREAS**, a resolution authorizing this municipality to apply for such tonnage grants will memorialize the commitment of this municipality to recycling and indicate the assent of the Council of the Borough of Buena to the efforts undertaken by the municipality and the requirements contained in the Recycling Act and recycling regulations; and

**WHEREAS**, such a resolution should designate the individual authorized to ensure that the application is properly completed and timely filed.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Borough of Buena that the Borough of Buena hereby endorses the submission of a 2013 Municipal Recycling Tonnage Grant Application to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, Office and Recycling and designates William Nimohay to ensure that the said application is properly filed.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the monies received from the recycling tonnage grant be deposited in a dedicated recycling trust fund to be used solely for the purposes of recycling.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that Buena Borough will publish in the local newspaper of record and post at the county administration building and other locations including on-line a public notice announcing the appointment of the Fair Housing Officer and the availability of local fair housing advisory services.

Dear Mayor and Council,

My partners and I are in negotiations to purchase all 15 of the remaining lots on Buena Drive in a cash deal with a 10 day close. Since the beginning, the attorney for Bank of America informed us of the borough's intention to call in the bond of the previous builder, Einhorn Construction, in order to cover the cost of the remaining site improvements. The improvements are, but not limited to: street lighting, final asphalt overlay, landscaping, and storm water management pipe clean out. Our offer is completely predicated on the borough calling in Einhorn Construction's bond. If the borough does not call in the bond to cover the site improvements, the project may be deemed unfeasible and the land could sit unimproved for several more years. It is our intention to begin building immediately after taking ownership of the land. Mr. Tonetta has assured me that he will discuss this during the next council meeting. I am requesting this matter be formally placed on the agenda for the next council meeting being held on March 24, 2014.


