WHEREAS, the Supervising Emergency Medical Technician is under the direct supervision and authority of the Chief of Police which position no longer exists in the Borough of Buena; and

WHEREAS, the functions of the Chief of Police have been assigned to the Director of Public Safety in accordance with Ordinance No. 604, as amended.

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Buena as follows:

1. Ordinance No. 605 shall be amended at Paragraph Three as follows:
2. The Supervising Emergency Medical Technician shall directly report to and act under the direct supervision and authority of the Director of Public Safety and in the absence of the Director of Public Safety, the two (2) Assistant Directors of Public Safety. The chain of command for Division employees and volunteers shall function accordingly.
2. All Ordinances or part of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.

WHEREAS, the functions of the Chief of Police have been assigned to the Director of Public Safety in accordance with Ordinance No. 604, as amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Buena as follows:

3. Ordinance No. 570 shall be amended at Paragraph Three as follows:

3. The Emergency Management Coordinator shall directly report to and act under the direct supervision and authority of the Director of Public Safety and in the absence of the Department of Public Safety the two (2) Assistant Directors of Public Safety. The chain of command for Division employees and volunteers shall function accordingly.

2. All Ordinances or part of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

ORDINANCE NO. 616 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 604, AN ORDINANCE
 AMENDING CHAPTER 45 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF BUENA
 ENTITLED PUBLIC SAFETY DEPARTMENT. M/Cugini S/Baker

WHEREAS, Borough Council of the Borough of Buena has adopted Ordinance
 No. 604 which amends Chapter 45 of the Code of the Borough of Buena entitled

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Public Safety Department recognizing that the Borough of Buena Police Department shall be headed by the Director of Public Safety; and

WHEREAS, Borough Council of the Borough of Buena has determined that it is in the best interest of the Borough that the Director of Public Safety also maintain direct supervisory powers over the Emergency Medical Services which have been established in accordance with Ordinance No. 570, as amended; and

WHEREAS, based upon the anticipated services to be provided by the Director of Public Safety including the responsibilities required in accordance with Section 45-3, Article II of Chapter 45 of the Code of the Borough of Buena as well as the responsibilities provided in accordance with Ordinance No. 570, as amended, it is determined that the position of the Director of Public Safety shall be a full-time, unclassified position.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Buena as follows:

1. Section 45-2 shall be amended as follows:

S45-2 Police Force and Division of Emergency Medical Services.

A. There shall be and hereby is established within the Department of Public Safety a full-time Police Force for the Borough of Buena, which shall consist of such number of superior officers and patrolmen as may hereafter, from time to time, be appointed by resolution of the Borough Council, upon recommendation of the Director of Public Safety and consistent with the annual budget of the Borough of Buena. This subsection is intended to ratify the existence and operation of the Police Department which has historically operated within and served the Borough of Buena and to satisfy statutory requirements of the enabling legislation as amended.

The Police Department shall preserve the public peace; protect life and property; detect; arrest and prosecute offenders of the laws of the State of New Jersey and the Ordinances of the Borough of Buena; direct and control traffic; provide attendance and protection during emergencies; provide appearances in court; cooperate with all other law enforcement agencies; and provide training for the efficiency of its members and officers.

B. The Division of Emergency Medical Services is established and created in accordance with Ordinance No. 605 within the Buena Borough Police Department which is headed by the Emergency Medical Technician, appointed by the Mayor with the advice and consent of Borough Council. The Emergency Medical

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Technician shall directly report to and act under the direct supervision and authority of the Director of Public Safety and in his or her absence the two (2) Assistant Directors of Public Safety.

2. Section 45-3 shall be amended as follows:

§45-3 Director.

Under the general direction of the Mayor and Council, the Director of the Department of Public Safety shall be appointed by the Mayor of the Borough of Buena, subject to the confirmation of Council, and may be the Mayor or a member of Council. The Director shall be the head of the Department, shall have general supervision and direction thereof and shall take such measures as he may deem necessary for the preservation of peace and good order and the enforcement of the laws of the State of New Jersey and the Ordinances of the Borough of Buena. Nothing herein shall empower the Director of Police to perform those duties which are reserved to law enforcement personnel.

The Director shall provide the Mayor and Council a report on a monthly basis, or a shorter period if required, of the operations of the Buena Borough Police Department including statistics and a general report of the Department.

The Director of Public Safety is established in the unclassified local service. The position shall be a full-time, regularly 37.5 hours and shall receive a salary in accordance with the salary Ordinance of the Borough of Buena. The position shall not be entitled to compensatory time or over-time but shall be entitled to flex time.

3. All Ordinances or part of Ordinance inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

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4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.

The position shall be full time, 40 hours per week, payable at an hourly rate as established by annual Salary Ordinance.
- There is hereby established in the classified local service the position of Clerk III. The definition, examples of work requirements, work experience and knowledge and ability are set forth in Job Specification 02773 published by the New Jersey Civil Service Commission. The position shall be

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full time, 40 hours per week, payable at an hourly rate as established by annual Salary Ordinance.
