WHEREAS, in all other respects Chapter 181 entitled “Property Maintenance” shall remain in full force and effect;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Buena, County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of same as follows:

Section 1:

All references to "International Property Maintenance Code, 2018 Edition" in Chapter 181 entitled "Property Maintenance" shall be amended to "International Property Maintenance Code, 2024 Edition, and as subsequently amended and revised".

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Section 2:

Chapter 181.3 entitled “Repealer” shall be deleted in its entirety and be replaced with the following language:

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this amending ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of their inconsistencies only.

Section 3.

Severability.

Should any section, clause, sentence, phrase or provision of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Section 4.

When effective.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication in accordance with law.

WHEREAS, the Buena Borough Municipal Utilities Authority (BBMUA) and Borough of Buena recognize that the sanitary sewer gravity system is aging and in a state of deterioration which requires reconstructing; and

WHEREAS, the BBMUA has identified three areas of concern; East Summer Road from Route 40 to Sumner Avenue; West Avenue from Route 619 Wheat Road to West Atlantic Avenue and West Atlantic Avenue from Central Avenue to West Avenue; and

WHEREAS, upon repairing and reconstructing the sanitary sewer mains, it will be necessary for the roads to be reconstructed and the Borough and BBMUA find it to be economical for the roads and sewer repairs to be done together and to provide new roads on the areas marked for repairs; and

WHEREAS, the Parties recognize the benefits and economies to be achieved by utilizing shared services for the purchase of commodities such as rock salt and related products that can be done more efficiently in combination then separately and the Parties are authorized, pursuant to the Uniform Shared Services Consolidation Act, N.J.S.A.40A: 65-1, et seq., to enter into a shared services agreement with any other local unit to provide or receive any service that each local unit could perform on its own.

WHEREAS, the BBMUA and the Borough intend upon entering into a Shared Services Agreement to provide the much needed work to the Borough infrastructure and intend upon obtaining funding through the New jersey Infrastructure Bank in an amount of not less than \$3,000,000.00 to cover most of the cost of the project

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RESOLUTION NO. 203-24

A RESOLUTION APPOINTING THE QUALIFIED PURCHASING AGENT TO SERVE AS THE PUBLIC AGENCY COMPLIANCE OFFICER IN THE BOROUGH OF BUENA

WHEREAS, The New Jersey Department of the Treasury, Division of Contract Compliance and Equal Employment Opportunity in Public Contracts, is charged with enforcing N.J.S.A.10:5-31 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the statute applies to each political subdivision and agency of the State of New Jersey, and includes procurement and service contracts as well as construction contracts; and

WHEREAS, the statute provides that no public contract may be awarded nor any monies paid until the prospective contractor has agreed to contract performance which complies with an approved, Affirmative Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Buena is required to designate a Public Agency Compliance Officer in accordance with N.J.S.A.10:5-31 to ensure compliance of this statute by the Borough.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Borough of Buena that the Qualified Purchasing Agent is hereby designated as the Public Agency Compliance Officer for the Borough of Buena in accordance with N.J.S.A.10:5-31.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this Resolution shall be submitted to the State of New Jersey, Division of Contract Compliance and Equal Employment Opportunity in Public Contracts, immediately after adoption and execution.

RESOLUTION NO. 204-24

A RESOLUTION APPOINTING WILLIAM NIMOHAY, FUND COMMISSIONER AND VALERIE SANTAGATA-JONES, ALTERNATE FUND COMMISSIONER FOR THE ATLANTIC COUNTY MUNICIPAL JOINT INSURANCE FUND JANUARY 1, 2025 AND EXPIRING DECEMBER 31, 2026

WHEREAS, the Borough of Buena, is a member of the Atlantic County Municipal Joint Insurance Fund, hereinafter referred to as "FUND"; and

WHEREAS, the Bylaws of the FUND require that in the manner generally prescribed by law, each member shall appoint one (1) Fund Commissioner and may appoint one (1) Alternate Fund Commissioner to the Fund. Each Fund Commissioner shall be either a member of the local unit's governing body, or one of its employees and that no individual may serve as Fund Commissioner for more than one (1) member; and

WHEREAS, N.J.A.C. 11:15-2.6 states that a Fund Commissioner who is a member of the appointing local unit's governing body, shall hold office for two years or for the remainder of his/her term of office as a member of the local unit's governing body, whichever shall be less; and

WHEREAS, N.J.A.C. 11:15-2.6 states that a Fund Commissioner who is an employee of the appointing member shall hold office at the pleasure of the member and can be removed by the member at any time without cause; and

WHEREAS, The Borough of Buena recommends the appointment of William Nimohay to serve as Fund Commissioner and the appointment of Valerie Santagata-Jones as Alternate Fund Commissioner in accordance with the FUND Bylaws.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough of Buena that it does hereby appoint William Nimohay as Fund Commissioner and Valerie Santagata-Jones as Alternate Fund Commissioner to the Atlantic County Municipal Joint Insurance Fund, January 1, 2025 expiring December 31, 2026.

WHEREAS, the Borough Council finds it to be in the best interest of the Borough to exercise the option for the one year renewal for animal control services and additional wildlife assessment and transport services with Shore Animal Control provided said professional meets all of the requirements as set forth in Resolution 18-24 which is attached hereto and made a part hereof including the submission of proof of a current state certification as well as a valid certification during the term of the contract, along with current certifications for all employees who may perform such services in the Borough of Buena and certifications of insurance for workers compensation and general liability arising out of its activities or actions on behalf of the Borough in an amount not less than \$1,000,000.00 per incident; and

WHEREAS, the Chief financial Officer has certified the availability of funds.
