**ORDINANCE NO. 702 AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A REVISION AND CODIFICATION OF
 THE ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF BUENA, COUNTY OF
 ATLANTIC, STATE OF NEW JERSEY.**

Be it ordained and enacted by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Buena, County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey, as follows:

§ 1-1. Code adopted; existing ordinances continued.

Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:49-4, the ordinances of the Borough of Buena of a general and permanent nature adopted by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Buena, as revised and codified and consisting of Chapters 1 through 229, together with an Appendix, are hereby approved, adopted, ordained and enacted as the Code of the Borough of Buena, hereinafter referred to as the "Code." The provisions of the Code, insofar as they are substantively the same as those of the ordinances in force immediately prior to the enactment of the Code by this ordinance, are intended as a continuation of such ordinances and not as new enactments. This ordinance and the Code adopted hereby shall supersede and replace the 1987 Code of the Borough of Buena (adopted 1-12-1987 by Ord. No. 329), as amended and supplemented.

§ 1-2. Code on file; additions and amendments.

- A. A copy of the Code has been filed in the office of the Borough Clerk and shall remain there for use and examination by the public until final action is taken on this ordinance. Following adoption of this ordinance, such copy shall be certified to by the Clerk of the Borough of Buena by impressing thereon the Seal of the Borough, as provided by law, and such certified copy shall remain on file in the office of the Borough Clerk, to be made available to persons desiring to examine the same during all times while said Code is in effect.

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B. Additions or amendments to the Code, when adopted in such form as to indicate the intent of the Mayor and Council to make them a part thereof, shall be deemed to be incorporated into such Code so that reference to the "Code of the Borough of Buena" shall be understood and intended to include such additions and amendments.

§ 1-3. Notice; publication.

The Clerk of the Borough of Buena shall cause notice of the passage of this ordinance to be given in the manner required by law. The notice of passage of this ordinance coupled with filing of the Code in the office of the Borough Clerk as provided in § 1-2 shall be deemed, held and considered to be due and legal publication of all provisions of the Code for all purposes.

§ 1-4. Severability.

Each section of this ordinance and of the Code and every part of each section is an independent section or part of a section, and the holding of any section or part thereof to be unconstitutional, void or ineffective for any cause shall not be deemed to affect the validity or constitutionality of any other sections or parts thereof.

§ 1-5. Repealer.

Ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions contained in the Code adopted by this ordinance are hereby repealed; provided, however, that such repeal shall only be to the extent of such inconsistency, and any valid legislation of the Borough of Buena which is not in conflict with the provisions of the Code shall be deemed to remain in full force and effect.

§ 1-6. Ordinances saved from repeal.

The adoption of this Code and the repeal of ordinances provided for in § 1-5 of this ordinance shall not affect the following ordinances, rights and obligations, which are hereby expressly saved from repeal:

- A. Any ordinance adopted subsequent to February 22, 2021.
- B. Any right or liability established, accrued or incurred under any legislative provision prior to the effective date of this ordinance or any action or proceeding brought for the enforcement of such right or liability.
- C. Any offense or act committed or done before the effective date of this ordinance in violation of any legislative provision or any penalty, punishment or forfeiture which may result therefrom.
- D. Any prosecution, indictment, action, suit or other proceeding pending or any judgment rendered prior to the effective date of this ordinance, brought pursuant to any legislative provision.
- E. Any franchise, license, right, easement or privilege heretofore granted or conferred.
- F. Any ordinance providing for the laying out, opening, altering, widening, relocating, straightening, establishing of grade, changing of name, improvement, acceptance or vacation of any right-of-way, easement, street, road, highway, park or other public place or any portion thereof.

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- G. Any ordinance or resolution appropriating money or transferring funds, promising or guaranteeing the payment of money or authorizing the issuance and delivery of any bond or other instruments or evidence of the Borough's indebtedness.
- H. Ordinances authorizing the purchase, sale, lease or transfer of property or any lawful contract, agreement or obligation.
- I. The levy or imposition of taxes, assessments or charges or the approval of the municipal budget.
- J. The dedication of property or approval of preliminary or final subdivision plats.
- K. All currently effective ordinances pertaining to the rate and manner of payment of salaries and compensation of officers and employees.
- L. Chapter 150, Land Use, adopted by Ord. No. 395, as amended.
- M. Any ordinance adopting or amending the Zoning Map.
- N. Any ordinance relating to or establishing a pension plan or pension fund for municipal employees.

§ 1-7. Changes in previously adopted ordinances.

- A. In preparing the revision and codification of the Borough's ordinances pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:49-4, certain minor grammatical and nonsubstantive changes were made in one or more of said ordinances. It is the intention of the Mayor and Council that all such changes be adopted as part of the Code as if the ordinances so changed had been formally amended to read as such.
- B. In addition, the changes, amendments or revisions as set forth in Schedule A attached hereto and made a part hereof are made herewith, to become effective upon the effective date of this ordinance. (Chapter and section number references are to the ordinances as they have been renumbered and appear in the Code.)

§ 1-8. Titles and headings; editor's notes.

- A. Chapter and article titles, headings and titles of sections and other divisions of the Code are inserted in the Code and may be inserted in supplements to the Code for the convenience of persons using the Code and are not part of the legislation.
- B. Editor's notes indicating sources of sections, giving other information or referring to the statutes or to other parts of the Code are inserted in the Code and may be inserted in supplements to the Code for the convenience of persons using the Code and are not part of the legislation.

§ 1-9. Altering or tampering with Code; violations and penalties.

It shall be unlawful for anyone to change, alter or tamper with the Code in any manner which will cause the laws of the Borough of Buena to be misrepresented thereby. Anyone violating this section shall be subject, upon conviction, to one or more of the following penalties: a fine of not more than \$2,000, imprisonment for not more than 90 days or a period of community service not exceeding 90 days, in the discretion of the Judge imposing the same.

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§ 1-10. When effective.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as provided by law.

RESOLUTION 81-21 RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PAYMENT OF ATTORNEYS' FEES ON THE CASE OF AADARI v. BOROUGH OF BUENA.

WHEREAS, the African American Data and Research Institute (AADARI) filed a Government Records Council appeal of an OPRA request made to the Borough on July 28, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Government Records Council awarded attorneys' fees to the Complainant and the parties were directed to attempt to amicably resolve the claim for attorneys' fees by way of Order dated July 27, 2021; and

WHEREAS, an amicable resolution was reached by the parties.

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WHEREAS, the Borough of Buena enacted Ordinance # 639-2016 titled Abandoned Real Property on June 27, 2016; and

WHEREAS, such ordinance was enacted as part of a countywide registry program implemented by the Atlantic County Improvement Authority who entered into a Shared Services Agreement with Pro Champs to track and register the properties for each participating municipality; and

WHEREAS, said Ordinance was enacted to regulate Vacant and Abandoned property and establishing a fee structure for registration of such properties; and

WHEREAS, on August 16, 2021, the Superior Court of New Jersey, Law Division in the case of McCormick, 106 LLC v. Community Champions held that municipalities do have a legitimate interest in passing regulations to address issues concerning vacant and abandoned properties, but struck the ordinances as arbitrary, capricious and unreasonable because they contain overly broad and unreasonable definitions of vacant and abandoned property; and

WHEREAS, on or about August 23, 2021, the Atlantic County Improvement Authority recommended that all municipalities who participate in the program and who have enacted these types of ordinances immediately suspend the application of the program.

AND NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Borough of Buena that the application and enforcement of Ordinance # 639-2016, found in Chapter 58 of Code of the Borough of Buena is immediately suspended.

ENGINEER'S REPORT:

FY2018 NJDOT Municipal Aid Project – Reconstruction of Forest Grove Road

The contractor has completed most of the punchlist items. Once the punchlist is complete, our office will close out the project and submit to the NJDOT for reimbursement.

FY2021 NJDOT Municipal Aid Project – Reconstruction of South Boulevard

Design of the project is essentially complete. South Jersey Gas has submitted a revised street opening permit application for replacement of their gas main in this area. Our office is reviewing the application with Mr. Nimohay to avoid any utility conflicts. The NJDOT grant funding is not sufficient to complete the project. We are reviewing with the CFO to determine if there is additional funding available.

Expansion of the Commerce Center Redevelopment Area

The public hearing is being scheduled in coordination with the new Board Solicitor.

NJDEP MS4 Compliance Work

The Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SPPP) is complete and has been posted to the Borough's website.
