At the behest of Councilman Marolda, Solicitor Tonetta prepared and disseminated two resolutions for Council's discussion and possible consideration at a future meeting. The resolutions, if adopted, will help pave the way for future grants under the Sustainable Jersey Program.

#### ENGINEER'S REPORT:

#### Kimberly Lane Storm Drain Pipe

The contractor has completed a large portion of the punchlist. Paving repairs were recently completed on Forest Grove Road

FY2013 NJDOT Municipal Aid Project - Reconstruction of Flower Street
The plans and specifications have been submitted to the NJDOT for review.

FY2014 NJDOT Municipal Aid Application - Reconstruction of Flower Street The Borough received \$180,000.00 in Municipal Aid funding. The Borough will request the NJDOT to combine the FY2013 and FY2014 allocations to allow the project to be constructed as one contract.

#### Louis Drive Drainage

Our office is currently evaluating alternatives to address the drainage issue.

#### Resurfacing of Forsythe Street

This project been incorporated into the bid for Flower Street.

#### Microsurfacing of Various Streets

The Borough has issued a purchase order to the State contract vendor for microsurfacing to microsurface the following streets:

Johns Avenue - Central Avenue to Willow Street

Willow Street (North) - North Boulevard to Forest Grove Road

#### COMMITTEE REPORTS:

RECYCLING: (COUNCILMAN MAROLDA)

Educational recycling in our schools was discussed. Councilman Marolda is pursuing the matter.

#### STREETS/ROADS: (COUNCILMAN JAMES)

Although Road Supervisor Nimohay was not present at this meeting, Administrator Trivellini provided those present with the following report on his behalf:

The Right to Know inspection was completed. Nothing was found but we were required to label our faucet as "water" and the sand shed as "sand".

Administrator Trivellini and Supervisor Nimohay researched the lighting at the commerce center at the behest of Councilman Marolda. The master tenant will be replacing all lights that are out as part of the lease agreement.

The playground equipment is here with the exception of a few pieces. Thanks to the efforts of Supervisor Nimohay, \$25,000.00 in transport charges was saved.

Leaf pick up will begin soon throughout the Borough.

Our vehicle and traffic ordinances are being reviewed and updated.

#### FINANCE: (COUNCILWOMAN BAKER)

Council President Baker disseminated the Summary Budget Account Status Report in an effort to make everyone aware of their department's status.

#### RECREATION: (COUNCILMAN ZAPPARIELLO)

Councilman Zappariello reported that the Recreation Commission will be making a recommendation to Council to revise the rules for use of the parks and the ability to charge fees when organizations use our parks and fields.

PUBLIC SAFETY/STREET LIGHTS: (COUNCILMAN CUGINI) no report

BLDGS/GROUNDS/IMPROVEMENTS: (COUNCILMAN MCAVADDY) no report

#### PUBLIC PORTION OF MEETING:

Bill Coltri of Forest Grove Road was present to discuss drainage on Weymouth Road. Mr. Coltri felt a portion of the problem has to do with Bellview Winery. Solicitor Tonetta stated that there is nothing that can be done so long as the natural flow of water wasn't altered. In addition, there is the Right to Farm Act.

Brian Fatcher of Kimberly Lane was present to discuss the Kimberly Lane Drainage project. Mr. Fatcher stated that he removed man hole covers and was of the opinion that there is a problem with the tie in of the pipes. Engineer Walberg assured Mr. Fatcher that the pipes were tied in correctly. Mr. Fatcher further stated that he had representatives of the State drainage department on site and was assured this was a public health issue. Solicitor Tonetta requested that the State representatives send documentation to Administrator Trivellini for review and follow up.

A discussion ensued regarding raising the speed limit on Kimberly Lane. Currently the speed limit is posted at 20 M.P.H., which is illegal in NJ. Mr. Fatcher expressed his concern with raising the speed limit to 25 M.P.H.
