Mayor Zappariello reviewed the Agenda items.

Administrator Report - Council has a copy of the draft to submit to the state for the layoff process. Auditor approved it and she would like to send it tomorrow to follow the timeline of having it sent to the employees by November 15, 2017 to have Franklin Township start on January 1, 2018. Administrator McCrea also advised she was in contact with the union representative and she is going to send him a list of the members affected and their status and they will help anyone who hasn't been placed with another agency.

Councilman Walker and Councilman McAvaddy arrived at 6:18pm.

Administrator McCrea attended a meeting with Bob and at this time the bike path and safe sidewalks is not worth looking into at this time. In the future we can check again to see if we qualify for more grants.

Also, there is a workshop reclaiming abandon properties on November 2nd and she asked Council if they would like her or someone else to attend. They suggested Pam Johnston attend.

Solicitor Report - ACUA began solid waste collection. Bill Nimohay advised there we no issues in the transition as far as he is aware. Also, Mr. Tonetta attended a COAH meeting and proposed we would follow the expert's obligations.
